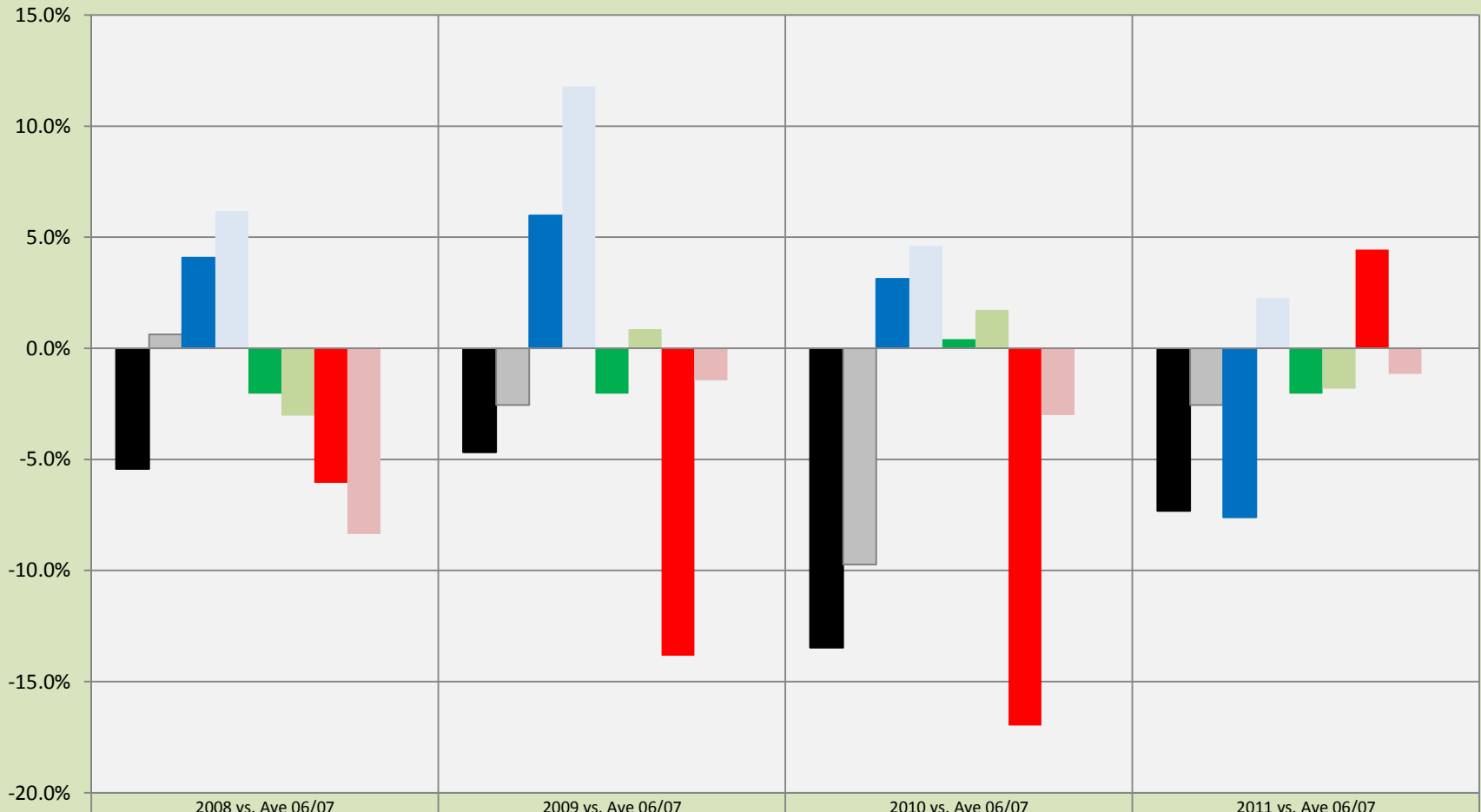


# Lafayette Median Prices: 2008 to 2011 vs Average of 2006:2007
